Cost

For the 2019/2020 academic year, the full cost of this qualification will be met by DfE Scholarship funding for applicants that currently work in category 5 and 6 areas (which includes Wolverhampton) and those working in MATs or dioceses which cover those areas; and for applicants who do not already hold the NPQ or have not previously attempted the NPQ for which they are applying.

For those applicants who do not meet the above criteria, the cost will be £1,800
