

### **Network Overview**

ConnectEd Partnership's Secondary NQT Professional Development Network is designed to support NQTs in their first year in the profession. It provides a regular forum to network with other NQTs in the city and to engage in CPD activities which will support them to meet the Teachers' Standards.
