What is the programme?

An Eco-Friendly activism project for Secondary schools across the Black Country supporting school's sustainable recovery. The programme provides training, guidance and resources to enable a group of pupils to supports the schools PE, Sport and Physical Activity and wider school offer across 6 themed areas

- Mental Wellbeing
- Inclusion
- Diversity
- The Virtual offer
- Partnerships and the Community
- Influencing Change

Each Navigator will receive training and be provided with resources for them to carry out a range of tasks across the school. The project will also provide training for a nominated lead from the school enabling them to implement the project across school with support from Active Black Country throughout.

The Rainbow Navigators programme will develop pupils' soft skills and enable them to capture this through a portfolio of evidence that can support the wider development of each pupil's employability skills.

Who is it for?

The Rainbow Navigators project is targeted at 12 pupils from a year 9 class in your school.

Timescales

The programme will launch in the summer term (April 2021) with training provided to schools and their Rainbow Navigators either virtually or face to face subject to the latest guidelines from DFE.
