Targeted Support Funding for NPQ Participants

State-funded schools with 1 to 600 pupils will be paid £200 for each teacher or leader they employ who undertakes a National Professional Qualification (NPQ) funded by a DfE scholarship.

The £200 payment is on top of the full NPQ scholarship and payments are awarded for each single NPQ participant.

How does the funding work?

- ✔ The £200 payment is designed to help teachers and leaders in smaller settings who may find it harder to engage with professional development
- ✔ Payments will be grant funded in arrears via existing Education and Skills Funding Agency (EFSA) channels the summer after NPQ participants begin their course
- ✔ The £200 payment will be automatically paid for each NPQ participant - no application necessary
- ✔ Payments awarded for NPQLT, NPQLTD, NPQLBC, NPQEYL, NPQLL, NPQSL, NPQH, & NPQEL
